ing facility.

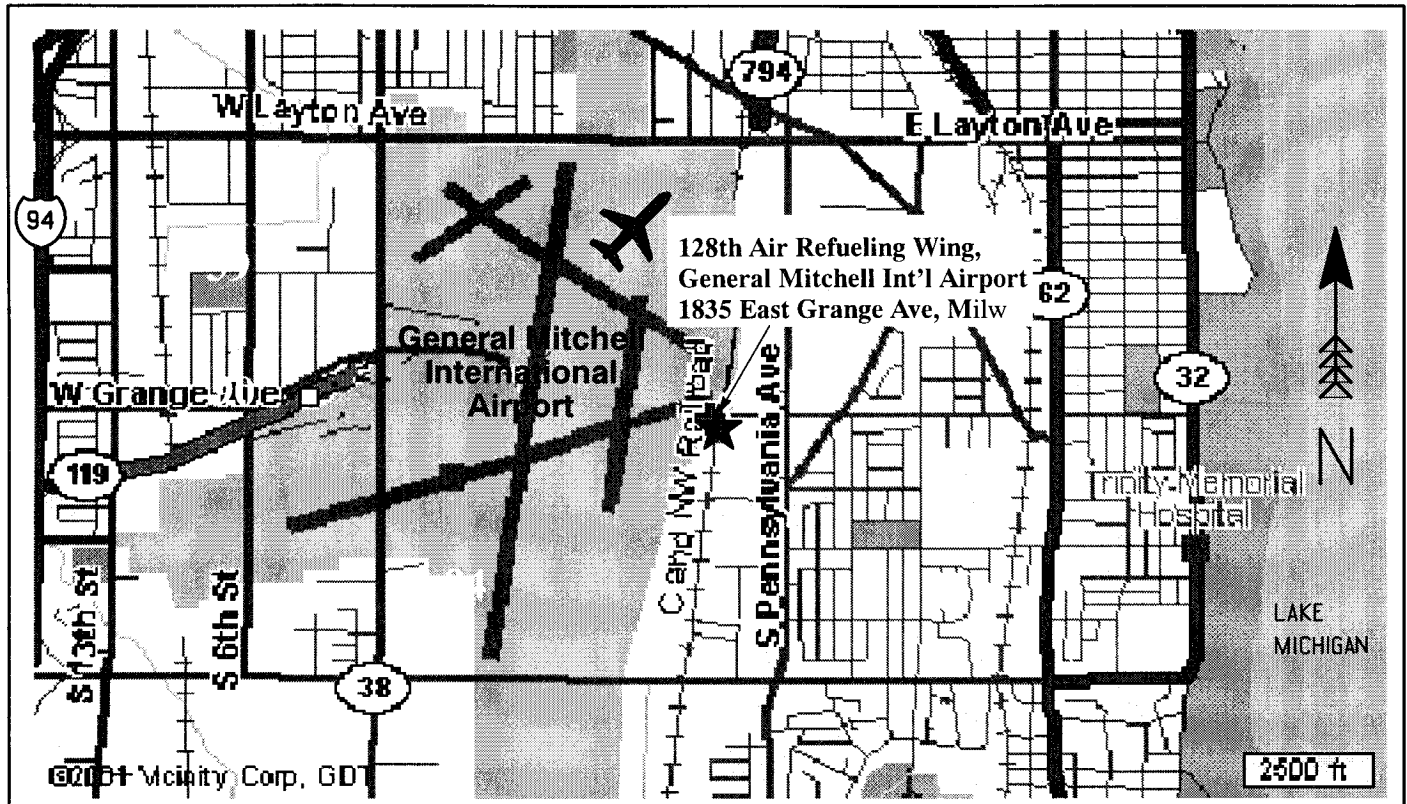
Aircraft: The 128th operates and maintains the
Boeing aircraft KC-135R "Stratotanker." Operated by a
four member crew, the aircraft is capable of air to air
refueling of U.S. and NATO military aircraft. The air-
craft is capable of transporting large volumes of fuel and
personnel. With a long range flying capability, the
KC-135R is often used to transport personnel and refuel
other aircraft during the same mission. With this dual
ability, the KC-135R is one of the most cost effective
weapon systems in the U.S. military!

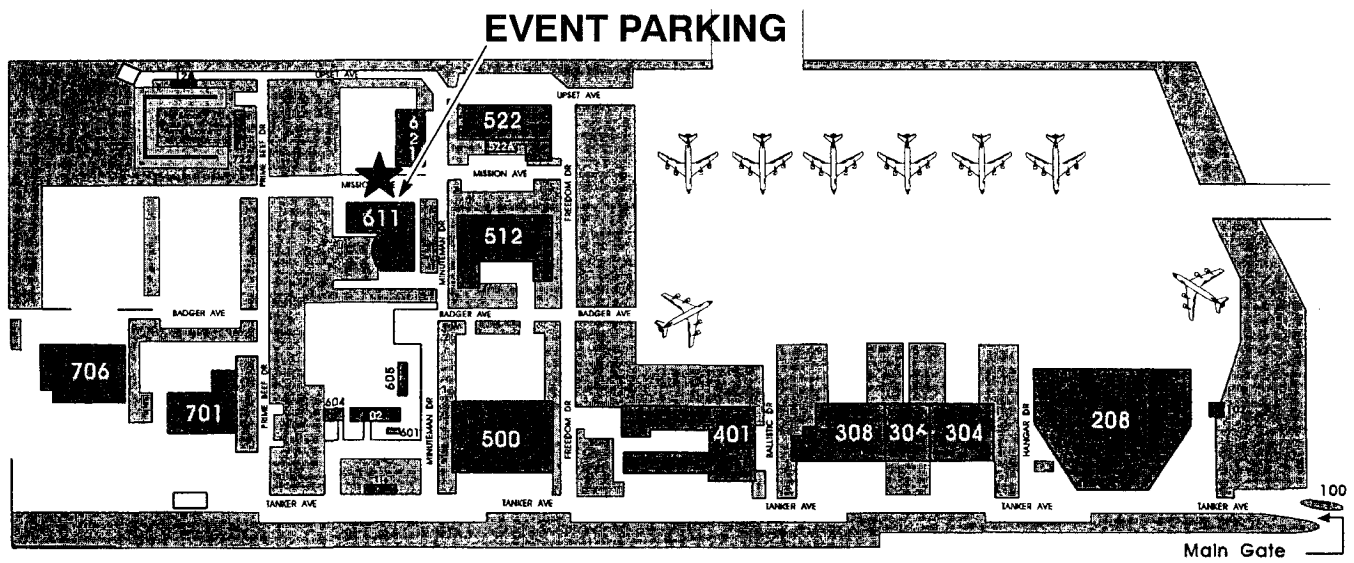
