MAY MEETING - FAMILY NIGHT

TOPIC: Wisconsin Air national Guard 128th Air Refueling Wing - General Mitchell Int'l Airport



Chief Of Staff, Lt. Col. Jim Waters and the 128th Air Refueling Wing will be hosting the Milwaukee SAE Section on May 16th for our annual "family event".

Members of the Wing will present an overview of the Wing's mission and operations followed by a tour of its facilities and supporting equipment including an "onboard" tour of a KC135R Stratotanker and a tour of their jet engine test facility. The meeting and tour will be preceded by cocktails in the Wing's "Guard House" lounge and will be followed by a buffet dinner in the Wing's dining facility.

Aircraft: The 128th operates and maintains the Boeing aircraft KC-135R "Stratotanker." Operated by a four member crew, the aircraft is capable of air to air refueling of U.S. and NATO military aircraft. The aircraft is capable of transporting large volumes of fuel and personnel. With a long range flying capability, the KC-135R is often used to transport personnel and refuel other aircraft during the same mission. With this dual ability, the KC-135R is one of the most cost effective weapon systems in the U.S. military!






