**PETERBILT TRUCKS – OVERVIEW OF THE CLASS OF THE TRUCKING INDUSTRY**

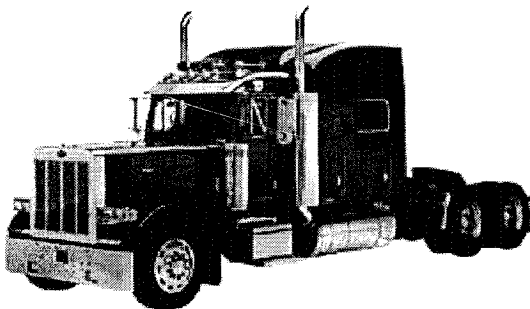

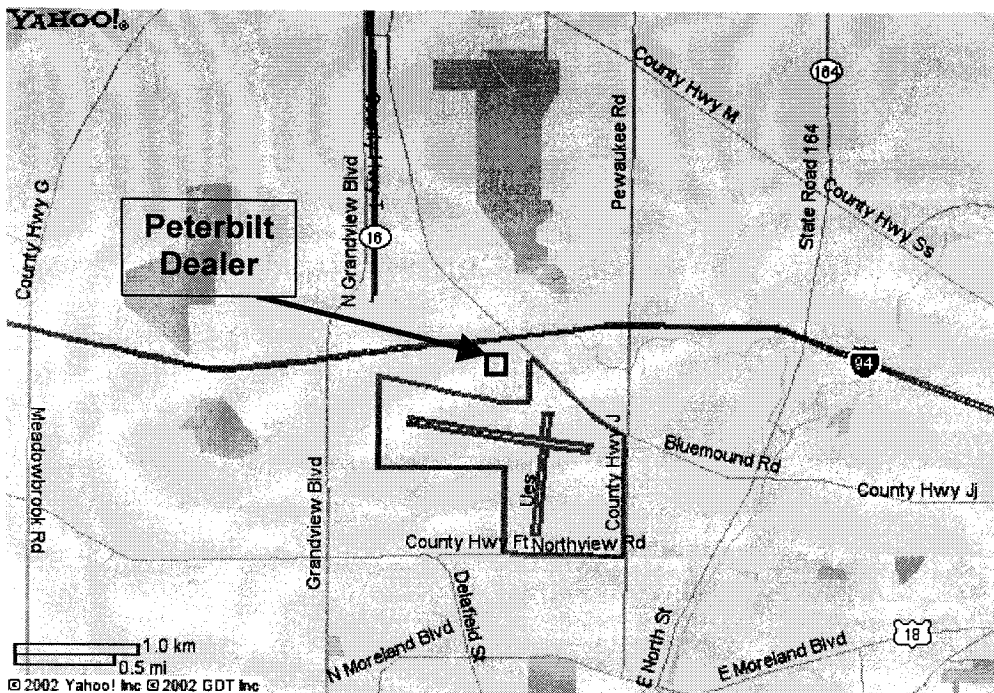
