



We learned that there has been a tremendous amount of work completed to replicate the flyer's exact specifications through available sketches, pictures and a few badly aged parts. Using wind tunnel testing the flyer's propellers and flight characteristics have been measured and documented in great detail. The aerodynamics of the flyer continues to be studied and the mix of history and engineering is amazing. Do you realize that the Wright's first flyer had a 2 mile an hour window for take off?
