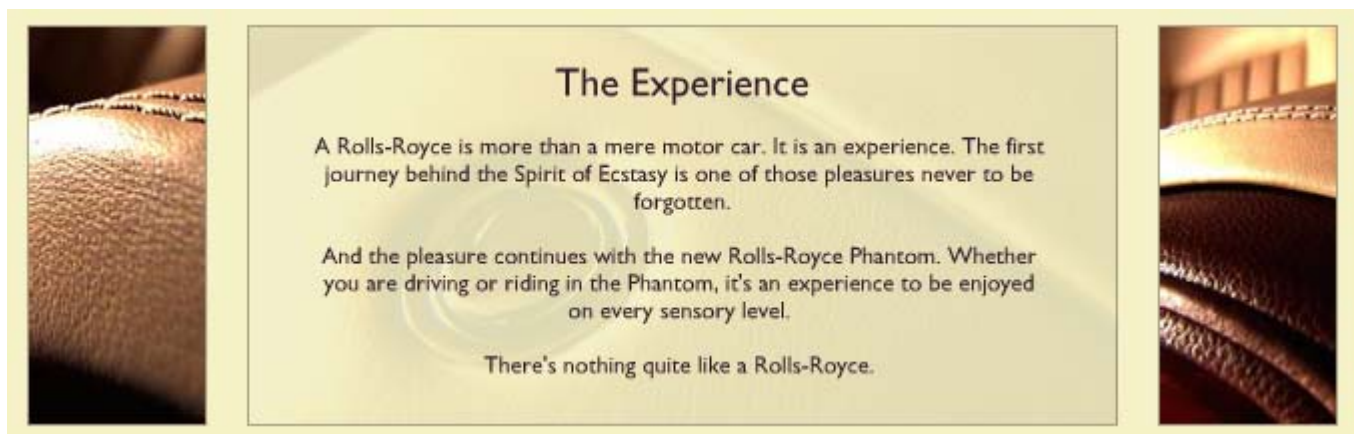
All classic vehicles will be on display at the main building within Whitnall Park prior to dinner.

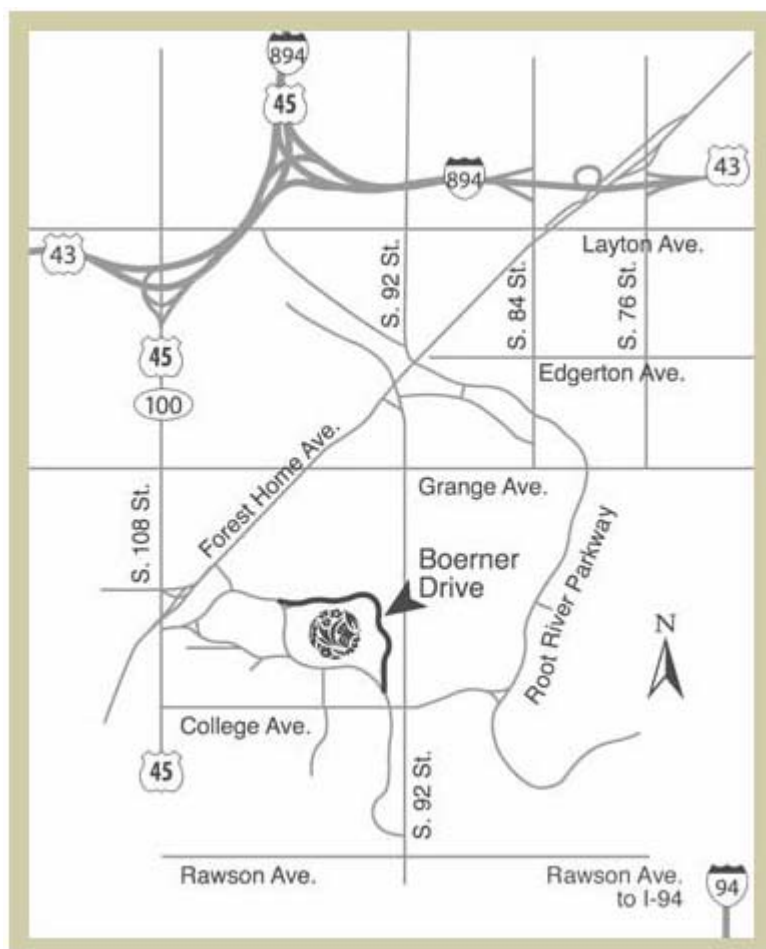
