Mr. Trafton is President & CEO of Super Steel Products
Corporation and Super Steel Schenectady, Inc., since mid 2005.
Super Steel Products is a \$90 - \$100 million revenue
organization that provides complex fabrication and assembly
solutions to the freight, passenger rail, construction, industrial,
and agricultural markets. Of particular note, Super Steel has
partnered with Sumitomo and Nippon Sharyo in the completion of
over 350 bi-level passenger rail vehicles. In late 2005 Mr.
Trafton acquired the largest share of interest in the privately held
business.

Prior to his current role, Mr. Trafton was the CFO for Super Steel from mid 2004 to mid 2005. Other experiences include roles as Controller at Helgesen Industries in Hartford, Wisconsin, as well as operational accounting roles at Leeson Electric Corporation (Grafton, Wisconsin) and Wacker Corporation (Menomonee Falls. WI).

Mr. Trafton holds a Master of Business Administration as well as a Bachelor of Business Administration - Accounting from the

University of Wisconsin Milwaukee. Finally, Mr. Trafton is both a Certified Public Accountant (CPA) as well as a Certified Management Accountant (CMA).


