### A little background about Caterpillar...





Wherever you go in the mining world, you'll find Caterpillar. From underground coal mines in China to surface gold mines in Mali to the oil sands of Canada, our products are hard at work. Caterpillar serves the worldwide mining community through its Caterpillar Global Mining organization, headquartered in Oak Creek, Wisconsin. Global Mining is the single point of contact for global mineral producers and the primary link to the Caterpillar extended mining enterprise. We provide mine-specific product and

service solutions that help our customers enhance safety, improve efficiency, increase productivity and reduce cost per ton.

The Cat® equipment product line currently consists of more than 300 machines used in dozens of industries. In addition to tractors, trucks, graders, excavators, scrapers and other heavy machinery used in the construction, mining and forestry industries, Caterpillar also makes diesel and gas engines used in Cat machinery, electric power generation equipment, locomotives and other

industrial equipment. With 50 production facilities in the United States and another 60 overseas, Caterpillar does about 44 percent of its business within the United States and 56 percent abroad. The company employs over 100,000 people; of those, about 4,000 are employed by the Caterpillar Global Mining organization.



The South Milwaukee facility began in 1893 as the Bucyrus Steam Shovel and Dredge Company of Wisconsin. It has grown to over 1,000,000 square feet of manufacturing space on a 75 acre campus. We build some of the largest equipment on earth: electric rope



shovels, ultra-class hydraulic excavators and aftermarket parts for draglines. We are proud of what we make, to be a member of this community and to be a part of Team Caterpillar.

The meeting tour will take you through the assembly building and weld shop where you'll see the equipment and components that build Cat electric rope shovel products.

Before and after the tour, you are welcome to visit the Heritage Museum, which maintains an archival collection that contains product literature, scale models and photographs that pre-date the move from Bucyrus Ohio to South Milwaukee. The oldest items in the collection include the manufacturing plate from the company's first dredge and engineering drawings on linen paper from the 1880s.

### **Large Caterpillar Mining Trucks**

Learn about how the largest trucks in the world are used in surface mining applications. Our speaker, John Ingle, will describe the application, drive system, and engineering challenges of developing this heavy duty equipment.



Caterpillar's largest truck, the 797F, is an ultra-class mining truck, designed and built by Caterpillar using components and systems that have evolved through years of rugged mining applications. It delivers excellent maneuverability, safe operation, low maintenance costs, lower operating costs and a comfortable ride. This gross machine weight is 1,375,000 pounds and carries a payload of 400 tons, that's 800,000 pounds! The truck is powered by a Cat<sup>®</sup> C175-20 quad turbocharged 20 cylinder diesel engine, delivering 4,000 gross horse power.



Mee-Kwon Park is located on one of the highest elevations in Ozaukee County and is a magnificent 18 hole facility that continues to get rave reviews from its customers. The course offers a variety of challenges; hills with gentle knolls, level terrain, trees, water, dog legs, and over 40 sand traps, which will keep you thinking about your next shot. The 18-hole course features 6,486 yards of golf from the longest tees for a par of 70. The course rating is 70.6 and it has a slope rating of 122.


