### IX. Meeting Discussion Topic: Golf Outing

- General:

- i. It would seem SAE Milwaukee Section of approximately 1000 members and 400 students should be able to have a successful and profitable golf outing.
- ii. In my work history with engineered product oriented companies, engineers were golfers! We sure didn't find them.
- iii. The fact is that except for a few board members and a sponsor or two, we did not have one SAE Milwaukee section member register to golf. One would sure think we should have gotten a couple of foursomes from members, retirees, students, to get this program rolling...
- Pluses:

- Profitable Our first two years has proven that a golf outing for the section can be very profitable to help fund a scholarship or student activities. This 2<sup>nd</sup> year event brought in \$2500+ to the section.
- ii. Company Sponsors The golf outing is a neat connection to our member companies as sponsors.
- iii. Sponsors Came Forward Examples were MacLean-Fogg and Johnson Controls, each for \$2000, Wow!
- iv. Raffle Items Companies did donate; Oshkosh Corporation, Briggs & Stratton, others. They could step up to be a sponsor in subsequent events.
- v. Model Proven We now have the "model" or format to do a golf outing, after two years experience. Of course, it can be improved each year.
- vi. Expenses We promoted the event at very low cost to the section; Public course, divot repair tools, mailings with monthly newsletter.
- vii. Early in the Season June was a good time to hold the event while enthusiasm for golf is at its peak. Holding it on a Saturday could help, yet I don't believe this was a major deterrent to signing up membership participation.
- viii. Cost of Event \$75 is a bargain for 18 holes of golf/cart, both lunch and a dinner. So, pricing of the event was not a problem.

## - Minuses:

- i. Lack of Participation Not one member came forth to register, in spite of monthly newsletter event announcements, three Tony/Wayne skits. Our skits did however bring forth at least one major sponsor MacLean-Fogg.
- ii. Board Support Board support was lacking. <u>All</u> would have to get behind such an event.
- iii. Committee Usually it was just a Tony/Wayne meeting...
- iv. Time Involved Tony had time to do this and had the passion to do it for the past two events. He cannot do that again. The leader of the event to really make it happen would have to spend 20hrs/week, at least for some of the calendar before the event.
