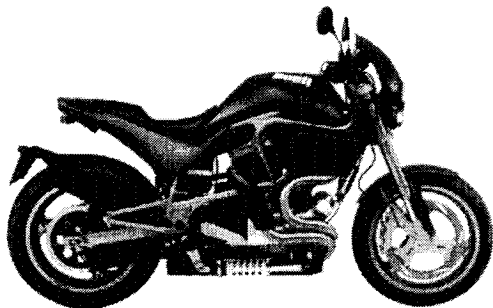

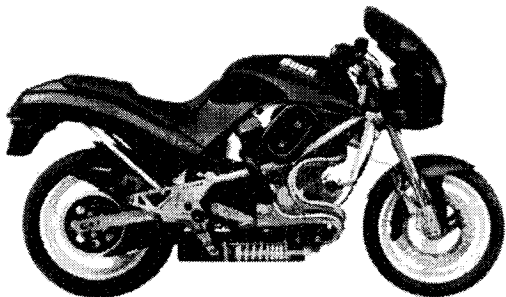

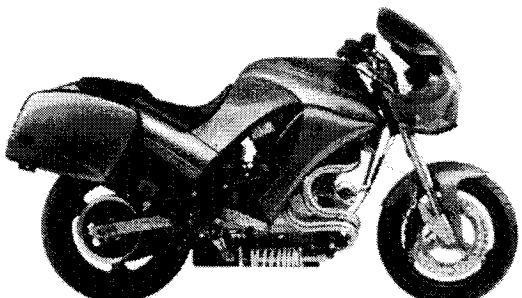

1996 S2 THUNDERBOLT.

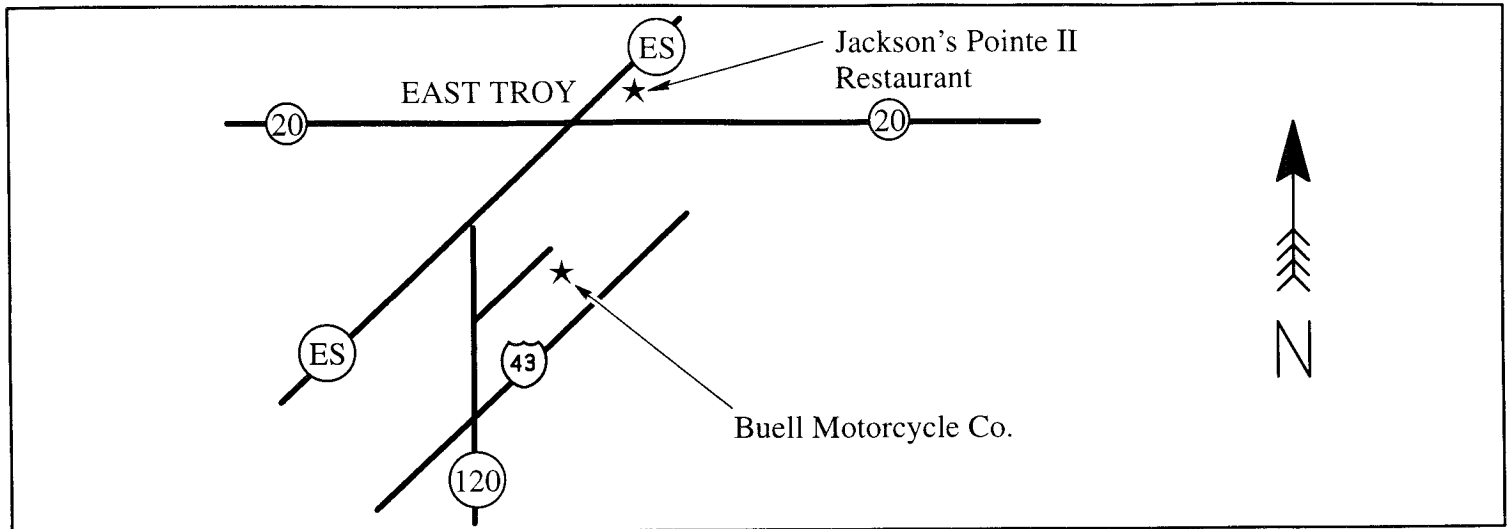

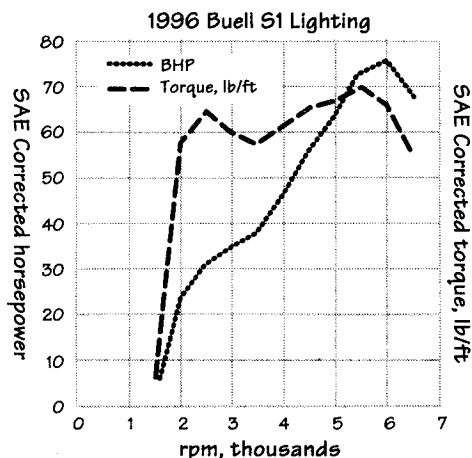
