

SPEAKER BIOGRAPHY


James J. Gralton

As an avid sportsman and duck hunter, Mr. Gralton wanted to buy a Hovercraft which he could be used for hunting and other recreational purposes. He also realized how difficult it was to rescue people who had fallen through thin ice. His search for a Hovercraft showed there were only a few on the market and those machines were often inadequate. With a few associates, Jim founded *Hovercraft America*, and proceeded to design and build air cushion vehicles primarily intended for rescue purposes. Their first product went into service in 1993 and is still operating in Door County. Most of their Hovercraft are sold to fire, police, natural resources and similar government agencies.



Hovercraft America's vehicle is equipped with a gel-coat hull, 5 passenger (1000 lb) capacity, 130 hp 4-cycle engine, positive air brake system, 84 segement Type-S skirt sytem.


