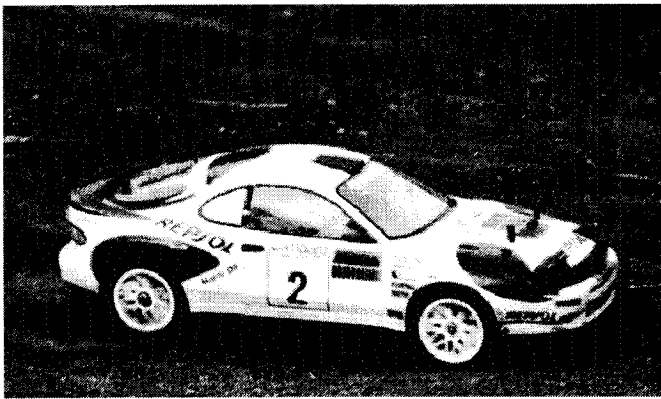

Speaker Biography:

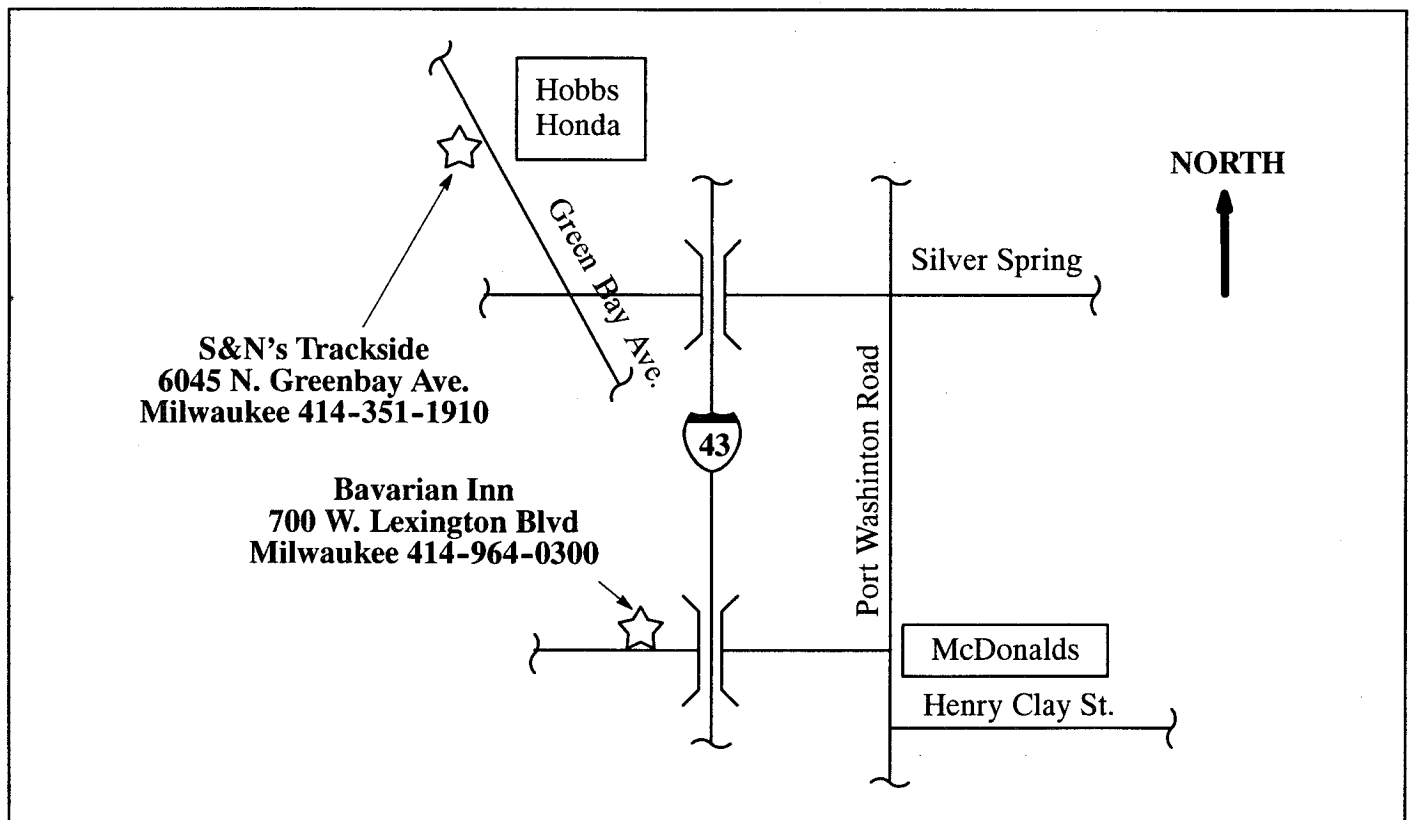

His involvement in auto racing has been life long. Working with his father (Duane Sweeney, Chief starter Indianapolis 500 retired) as a starter at both local and national late model stock cars and open wheeled events.

Mark started RC racing in 1980 and has been involved in both electric and gas racing. He reached a goal last year of being ROAR Gas National Champion in the "Open Class" at the Pembroke Speedway in New Hampshire.

GOVERNING BOARD ELECTIONS.

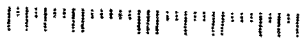

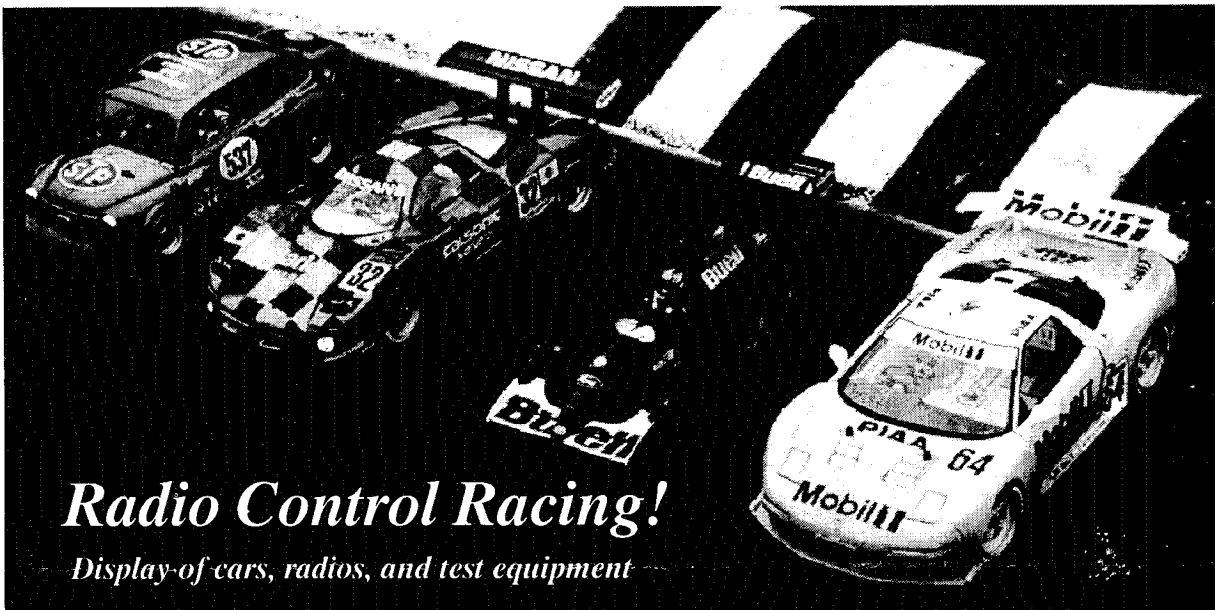
